SP.84.9 Amendment to the Senate Bylaws to add a member appointed by the  
Chancellor of the Military Education Council

BACKGROUND

Vice-Chancellor Goldwasser has informed our Committee of Chancellor Cribbet's wish to appoint another member to the Military Education Council. Although the Military Education Council is a campus body, its composition and charge appear in the Senate Bylaws largely because six civilian faculty members and 2 student members of the Council are elected by the Senate. The Bylaws should be amended to reflect the change.

The Military Education Council has been consulted about this proposal and concurs in its desirability,

PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO THE SENATE BYLAWS, PART F

1 3. Military Education Council. The Military Education Council is a  
2 campus body charged with reviewing staff appointments in military  
3 departments; reviewing and supervising military education curriculum;  
4 administering related budget, space, interdepartmental liaison and  
5 contract negotiations; and ensuring academic freedom within military  
6 departments.

7 The Council is composed of a chair and one non-voting member  
8 appointed by the Chancellor; six civilian faculty members elected  
9 by the Senate; one undergraduate and one graduate professional  
10 student, both elected by the Senate; the three military department  
11 heads ex officio with vote; and one student appointed by the Armed  
12 Forces Council. The six civilian faculty members are elected for  
13 two-year terms, three of them being elected each year. Three of

14       them must be senators, and three need not be. The student members  
15       chosen by the Senate are elected for one-year terms and need not  
16       be senators.
